

PROBLEM of a METHOD in MODERN PSYCHOLOGY

There are two basic methods: a psychological induction and psychological deduction.

The psychological induction is the method of classification of people with the help of "social models".

The psychological deduction is the method of formation of people with the help of the "cultural projects".

Both "social models" and "cultural projects" are a-priori factors. Though they determine individual life, but are not the facts of individual experience.

The opportunities of a psychological induction and psychological deduction are limited by a-priori factors.

The problem of psychological methods limitation can be solved by the creation of a genetic method.

The genetic method is a method of generation of the "subject project" of individual life by the man himself and its realization in the individual experience.

The "subject project" determines the individual life and simultaneously is the fact of individual experience.

The genetic method is a method of generation of the man by the man himself.

For a genetic method no a-priori limits, as the factors, which determine individual life, the man makes himself.

It means, that the man has not social, but universal nature.

The source of the man's origin is not the society, but the whole developing nature.
